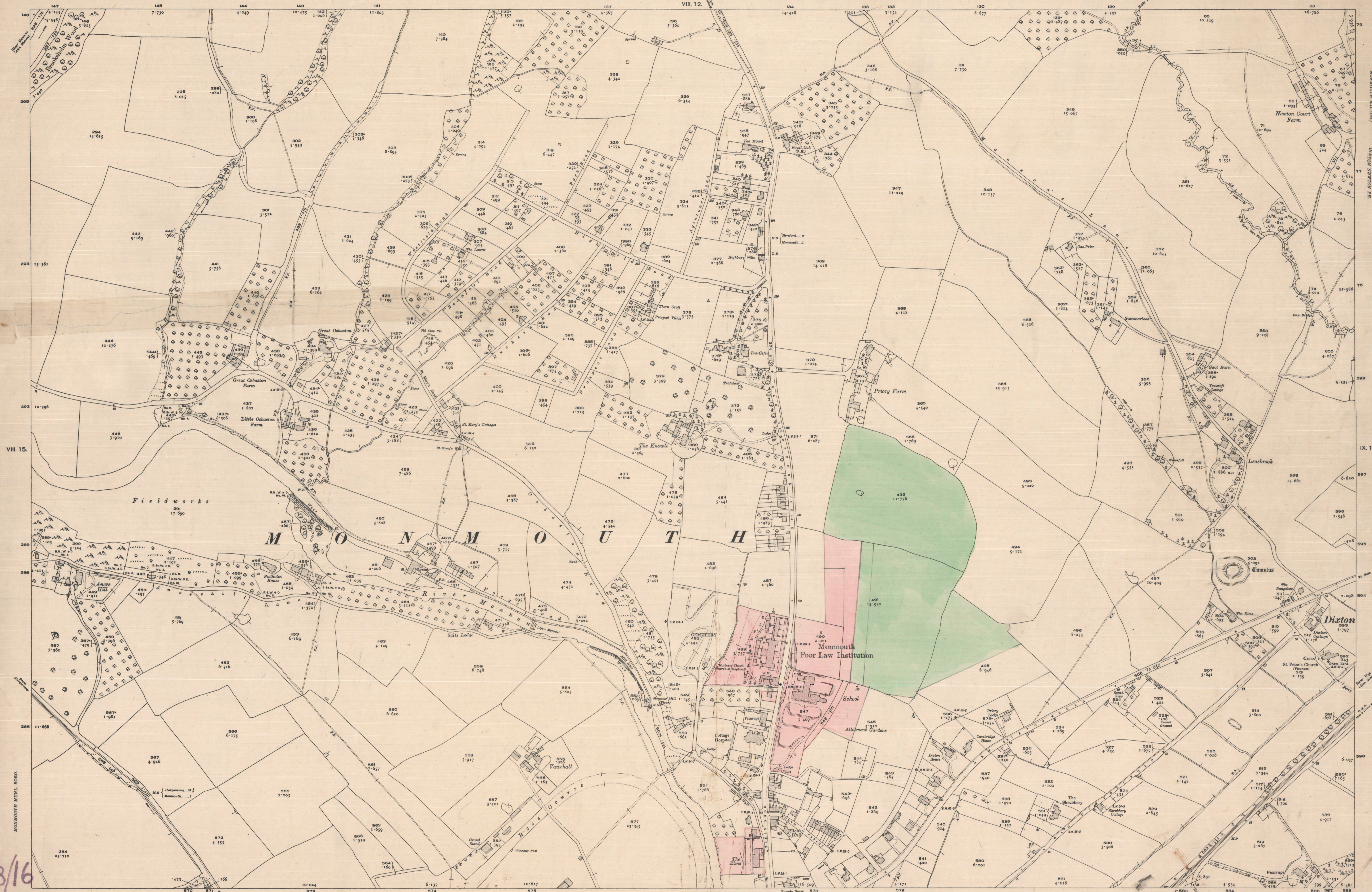

The Altitudes are given in Feet above Ordnance Survey Datum, which is about 0.65 of a Foot below the general Mean Level of the Sea.

Altitudes indicated thus () refer to Bench Marks on Buildings, Walls, &c. those marked thus () to surface levels.

Note.—To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Roods and Perches, multiply by 4, this will give Roods and Decimals of a Rood, multiply this Decimal by 40 thus obtaining Perches and Decimals of a Perch.

Example.—.367 = 1 Rood 0.20 P. Perch.
